Amanda Lee is a native of Malaysia . She received an Advanced Certificate in Piano Performance from The Associated Board of Royal Schools of Music in 1996. She also earned a Licentiate of Trinity College of Music (London) a year later. Following her studies at University-College Sedaya International in Malaysia, she received a Performance Grant Award to pursue a Bachelor of Music Degree at West Virginia University (WVU). She was named Outstanding Senior by the West Virginia University Foundation in 2000 and Young Artist Concerto Competition Winner in 2001. Amanda then pursued a Master's Degree in Piano Performance at WVU with the support of the International Peace Scholarship granted by the Philanthropical Educational Organization Foundation. During her doctoral studies, she received the WVU Minority Doctoral Teaching Fellowship, the Southern Regional Education Board Fellowship, and the Music Teachers National Association (MTNA) Student Achievement Recognition (StAR) Award.

Her teachers include Tamás Ungár, James Miltenberger, Loo Bang Hean, Veronica Leong, and Josephine Lim. She has played in master classes conducted by Jose Feghali, Jerome Lowenthal, Vladimir Shakin, Martin Berkofsky, and Tristan Lauber. She has performed in the Young Artists Recital of the 2004 Las Vegas Summer Music Festival and the Teachers Recital of the 2006 PianoTexas International Academy and Festival. Amanda has been on the faculties of WVU Community Music Program (1999 - 2006), Glenville State College (2002 - 2005) in West Virginia , and Washington and Jefferson College (2005 - 2006) in Pennsylvania . She is now an Assistant Professor of Music at Southwestern Assemblies of God University in Waxahachie , Texas
